




Who were Lois and Lawrence Somers?

Lois and Larry were lifelong Hawaii residents.

They believed their primary responsibility was to raise their four children to be contributing members of society with a good education that started in the home. They sacrificed much to ensure that the best education was a top priority, with learning becoming a life-long pursuit. Once their children were independent, Lois and Larry enjoyed traveling, learning about cultures around the world, but their hearts were always on Kauai where generations of Lois' family have lived. They loved the island's people, culture, and the land itself. They split their time between Honolulu and Makaweli. Both were active in the community with P.E.O. being central to both their social life and charitable work. Ruth Somers, Larry's mother, introduced Lois to P.E.O. and after nearly 50 years in P.E.O. Chapter C Oahu, and at the age of 96, Lois became a founding member of Chapter L Kauai. With appreciation for their parents' commitment to education, their children have established a P.E.O. Scholarship for a woman from west Kauai to further her education so she, too, can become a contributing member of society. This scholarship is a legacy to Lois and Larry's inspired lives and ideals.



WHO CAN APPLY

A west Kauai woman graduating high school **or** furthering her post-graduate level education who has been accepted and/or attending an accredited U.S. or Canadian college. Applicants should exhibit excellence in leadership, academics, extracurricular activities or work life, community service and potential for future success, preferably on Kauai, with an unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale. Applicants must be a citizen or legal resident of the U.S. or Canada.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Completed application sheet **and** essay answering questions
- High school or college transcript
- Listing of your extracurricular activities and volunteerism
- Two reference letters:

Make two copies of the recommendation form and request one recommendation from a teacher and one recommendation from a community member (employer, minister, etc.). Family members cannot be used as references. Follow up with them to be sure their letters are submitted by **February 21, 2026**.

HOW ARE APPLICANTS SELECTED

Applicants are selected through a two-step process, beginning with a blind scoring process where applications are ranked by a committee of reviewers. The highest scorers will be interviewed by the committee for final selection sometime March 2026.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNTS: \$2,500.00 and \$1,500.00

THE RECIPIENT ANNOUNCED: The scholarship winner will be notified by PEO Chapter L, Hawaii in May.
